## Volunteer Opportunities...

Sales & Cashier: Operate cash register, respond to customers' questions, assist customers in locating & loading materials, coordinate with Warehouse to keep shelves stocked.

Warehouse: Prepare, stock, and display donated materials, price items, general cleaning, assist in loading purchases, work with Sales & Pickup as needed.

Pickup: Collect donations, quality control responsibility, load, secure, transport, & unload donations, maintain clean & safe loading area, & maintain vehicles.

Office: Answering phones, customer service, data entry, & mailing.

Instruct a class: Teach a class about your interests, profession, or hobbies: window installation, wood restoration, arts & crafts, etc.

### Special Requirements

- Volunteers working in the warehouse must be able to lift 40 lbs.
- Volunteers cashiering must be trained on store policy regarding returns and credit, and cash register use prior to working at the cash register. No prior history of theft.
- Volunteers who wish to purchase items in the ReStore cannot price the items they wish to buy.
- Volunteers cannot be younger than 14.
- Minors and parent or guardian must sign a minor liability waiver.
- Any minor must be supervised by an adult: the ReStore will not provide supervision.
